- Increase of Biennial Fee,

- changes to NAC 641.152 clarifying the statement that a psychological assistant should be an employee of their supervisor,
- Changes to NAC 641. 154 clarifying language relating to wage requirements for psychological assistants, interns and trainees.
- Changes to NAC 641.080 clarifying language relating to obtaining supervision hours in the scope of teaching in an accredited university.
- Introduction of language relating to Foreign Applicants, regarding evaluation and processing of applicants from outside of the USA and Canada
- Introduction of transfer of Medical Records if a professional becomes incapable of maintaining them.
- Introduction of language clarifying certain requirements concerning licensure of person engaged in teaching of psychology in accredited universities.
