- *2. Discussion of AB65/Legislative update.

The Board members discussed possible options in saving the changes that were proposed in AB65. AB65 did not pass out of committee by the legislative deadline. Dr. Neighbors informed the members that the Legislative Counsel Bureau had said that many of the changes can take place within NAC 641, which doesn't require legislative approval.

Ms. Bradley discussed this option with the Board. Stating that while it is possible making these changes within NAC 641 it would make the chapter certainly longer. It was decided that the Board would attempt to attach the necessary changes to an active autism community related bill.

Ms. Bradley and the Board members discussed the most important parts of AB65, changes to NRS 641.100, 641.170, 641.172, 641.240 and 641.243 were determined to be the most imperative to allow the Board to provide the public and the behavior analysis community the most protection.

Dr. Neighbors and Ms. Ellis discussed current bills with the legislature we need to watch. AB315, AB316 and AB345 are the currently active bills that have some relation to the Boards suggested regulation changes. The legislative sub-committee of Dr. Lenkeit and Ms. Ellis was expanded to include Dr. Neighbors. It was determined to have a sub-committee phone meeting on Friday, April 29, 2011 at 7:30 A.M.

Dr. Lenkeit will draft the possible changes, with revision by Ms. Bradley. Ms. Ellis will identify the most appropriate of the possible bills, and any legislators that may be willing to assist the board. Dr. Neighbors will meet with the LCB liaison to further investigate the possible changes to NAC 641.

3. Public Comment.

Dr. Lenkeit moved to adjourn at 12:51 p.m.. Dr. Parry second. Board vote 4-0-0.
