(NRS 233B.126) Public comment that is willfully disruptive is prohibited, and individuals who willfully disrupt the meeting may be removed from the meeting. (NRS 241.030(5)(b)) The Board may convene in closed session to consider the character, alleged misconduct, professional competence or physical or mental health of a person (NRS 241.030). Once all items on the agenda are completed, the meeting will adjourn.

Now, Board staff and Dr. Walter request that the Board vacate the Stipulated Settlement Agreement in these cases, dismiss Case No. 17-1025B, and accept a Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Other Disciplinary Action in Case No. 17-1109, which contains specified terms for Dr. Walter to complete prior to any future reinstatement of her license in the future. Pursuant to NRS 233B.121(6) a voluntary surrender agreement constitutes disciplinary action.
